Tree Corps is a pilot arboriculture workforce development program designed to provide valuable training and entry-level job placement for Cleveland residents in the tree care industry. Tree Corps is a program funded through a generous grant from the Cleveland Foundation working to support Cleveland's urban tree canopy on public and private property.

PROGRAM DETAILS:

- 19-Week Workforce Development Program beginning in March 2018.
- 30 hours per week of paid time.
- Transportation provided to work sites from Cleveland Botanical Garden.
- Program will be roughly 60% hands-on and 40% classroom training, working alongside and taught by arboriculture professionals and International Society of Arboriculture (ISA) Certified Arborists.
- All Participants who successfully complete the program, and pass evaluations are eligible for Tree Care Apprentice and Tree Care Specialist Certifications validated through the Tree Care Industry Association (TCIA).
- Opportunities to connect with future employers.
- **Applications available January 1, 2018.** Interviews conducted in February. Limited spaces available.
