Program Description: MomsFirst is a home visitation program that helps mothers succeed during and after pregnancy. The MomsFirst mission to help mothers and families have healthy babies. MomsFirst was established in 1991 as the City's Healthy Family/Healthy Start Program. Since that time, the program has evolved beyond getting pregnant women into prenatal care. Today, our primary goal is to reduce the number of African American families who experience the death of a newborn before the first birthday and to improve birth outcomes for all families. Community Health Workers (CHW) provide home visitation, education and support to pregnant women throughout their pregnancies and make every effort to help ease the stress that comes with becoming a parent. It does not matter whether you are a first-time expectant mom or an experienced parent, MomsFirst will work with you and continue to support you until your child turns 2 years old. It is our desire to help you and your baby be healthy as possible and help you plan for the future.

Job Description: Recruit and maintain a minimum caseload of thirty (30) high risk pregnant women. Provide ongoing outreach, support, education, and referrals to meet needs of participant service plan. Maintain accurate and up to date documentation on all participant activity. Participate in ongoing continuing education and training. Some evening and weekend hours required.

Qualifications: A High School Diploma or GED required. Associate Degree required. Bachelor's Degree in Social Work or related field preferred. Must be knowledgeable of community health and social services resources and have 2-3 years' experience in outreach, case management, or home health care. **Candidate must have the CHW certification through the Ohio Board of Nursing or be willing to be certified as a condition of their employment if hired without it.** Must possess (internet, MS Word, etc.) Previous experience with computer based documentation preferred. Must have valid driver's license and reliable transportation.
